Sports Incentive Marks Policy

(This proposal will be implemented from the session 2025-26 even semester)

1. Purpose:

The objective of this policy is to recognize and reward the achievements of students who actively participate in sports and games, and to motivate them to maintain a healthy balance between academics and extracurricular excellence.

As an Autonomous Engineering Institution, **Jhulelal Institute of Technology** reserves the right to frame and implement this incentive marks policy, subject to academic council approval.

2. Scope:

This policy applies to all Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) students enrolled in regular programs under the autonomous curriculum of the institution.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

Students will be eligible for sports incentive marks if they:

- Represent the institute in recognized sports competitions at **zonal, inter-zonal, university, state, national, or international levels.**
- Maintain minimum attendance as per academic regulations (typically $\geq 75\%$).
- Have no history of disciplinary action.
- Submit valid proof of participation, attested by the Physical and Physical Education Director.



4. Approved Competitions:

Only participation in the following types of events will be considered:

- University/Inter-college Sports Meets.
- State & National Level Championships (organized by State Associations or Sports Authority of India).
- All India Inter-University Events (AIU-recognized).
- International Events (e.g., Asian Games, World University Games, etc.).
- Association/Federation Recognized Events.

5. Incentive Marks Allocation:

Note: Only the highest level of participation in a semester will be considered and Incentive marks for sports will be given once a year.

6. Application & Approval Process:

- 1. Submission:** Students must submit a formal application with supporting documents (certificates, event circulars) within 10 working days of the event.
- 2. Verification:** The application is verified by the Physical Director and forwarded to the

3. Incentive Marks Committee.

The Incentive Marks Committee comprises:

- Controller of Examinations (CoE)
- Head of the Department (HoD)
- Physical Director
- Faculty Sports Coordinator

- 4. Approval:** Final marks are approved in the Result Passing Board before declaration.

7. Marks Integration:

- Incentive marks will be added to internal assessment marks in relevant courses for the current semester.
- Maximum incentive per course shall not exceed 45% of internal marks (e.g., 45 out of 100).
- Alternatively, for overall GPA improvement, sports credit may be included in the extracurricular activities basket, if the curriculum provides for it.

8. General Conditions:

- A student can claim incentive marks in one semester only for a given event.
- Misuse or submission of false claims will attract disciplinary action.
- Students participating in multiple events will be considered for the highest-level event only in a semester.
- This policy shall not apply to repeat or backlog students unless approved by the Academic Council.

9. Policy Review & Amendments:

This policy is subject to periodic review and amendment by the Academic Council and Board of Studies based on feedback, statutory guidelines, or performance evaluation.
