



Rules & regulations for awarding “Grace Marks” to the students

1. 1 % of total marks shall be given (if required) as grace marks to the student in each semester in all the respective branches/programmes.
2. Defining the maximum grace marks must be done at semester level branch wise. It shall not be set at JIT level.
3. Grace will not be applied to the student who remains absent in examination / caught in unfair means case / scores zero marks in end semester examination.
4. Grace will not be applied to practical, project, NPTEL courses, Double minors and Honors courses.
5. In Grade Card in REMARK column, “G” must appear in front of the course which implies “PASS BY GRACE”. Also in abbreviations section on grade card following text must be printed – G : Pass by Grace
6. If the student clears the course in Resit or Supplementary examination by Grace marks then, R, G or S, G must appear in REMARK column respectively in grade card.
7. The existing notations used in TR for grace marks is OK and must be used as it is.
8. The students passing by grace marks are not eligible for awards/merits/medals etc.
9. SGPA and CGPA must appear on Grade Card & TR for the students passed by grace.
